Read the brief media extract below and note down your initial reaction to the information it contains in terms of beliefs you have about the use of guns in the USA.

About six in 10 United States high school students say they could get a handgun if they wanted one, a third of them within an hour, a survey shows. The poll of 2508 junior and senior high school students in Chicago also found 15% had actually carried a handgun within the past 30 days, with 4% taking one to school.
